

SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Adelaide is the capital city for South Australia and where the majority of the states population of 1.57 million people live. The city was designed by Colonel Light and the 1 sq mile of the CBD is surrounded by parklands which are used for most of Adelaide's cultural festivals and major events.

The metropolitan area stretches for 80 kms north to south bounded by the sea on the west and the Mt Lofty ranges on the east so sunrise and sunset are totally opposite to that experienced on the east coast of Australia.

South Australia was settled by farmers rather than convicts and this is reflected in the architecture and agriculture of the state.

World renown for its fine wines Adelaide is surrounded by boutique wineries and vineyards and has the greatest number of restaurants per capita of any state.

Enjoying a mediterranean climate with 4 seasons South Australians can take advantage of their outdoor lifestyle from a day at the beach to a stroll in the hills all within easy reach of the CBD.
